HONOREE 2019 – ST. PATRICK’S DAY PARADE

Gerry McLoughlin, an Eastchester resident for more than 22 years, is an Honoree for the Eastchester Irish-American Social Club’s (EIASC) 15th Annual St. Patrick’s Day Parade.
